HOW TO TAKE CARE OF YOUR NEW DOG

BUY NECESSARY SUPPLIES

like an ID tag, collar, toys, dog bed, and food and water bowls

STOCK UP ON FOOD

SCHEDULE A WELLNESS CHECK

with your local vet

PREPARE YOUR OTHER PETS

let them smell each other's belongings before introducing them

GIVE YOUR HOUSE A SAFETY CHECK

close off any areas where your new pet shouldn't be

START POTTY TRAINING ASAP

frequently take them to the place they should use to help avoid unwanted accidents

Going to The Vet Regularly



Going to the vet regularly can help find anything that might not be visible on the outside of your pet.

The vet will examine your pet from nose to tail and everything in between.

Your pet should get vaccinations and parasite prevention every year. Don't forget year-round heartworm prevention.

The vet will also be able to answer questions related to your pet's care.
